



Taking away our patients' transportation barriers

At Western Wisconsin Health, we believe that we can build a healthier tomorrow together, and to attain this, we are working to identify what our patients need most. One area of concern is the limited wheelchair accessible transportation for patients to their medical appointments in rural Wisconsin. Currently, transportation services that do exist can be expensive and difficult to coordinate with medical appointment times.

For many years, Western Wisconsin Health has offered a courtesy van for patients living in the service area to get to appointments at our main campus in Baldwin as well as our clinic in Roberts. Last year, Western Wisconsin Health provided over 3,000 rides for people who have transportation challenges. Riders are asked to make a donation of a few dollars, only if they are able, to cover some of the cost of the service. Currently, riders must be able to board the van independently and after five years our van will need replacement due to wear and tear in the next year.

Our goal is to raise \$75,000 for a new upgraded accessible van, which would include options to accommodate patients in wheelchairs. We hope you will consider a donation to help us reach our goal by the spring 2022. Your support for a new wheelchair accessible van will ensure that transportation barriers a patient may face do not prevent them from getting the medical care they need.
